Wellcare By Absolute Total Care offers an integrated Dual Special Needs Plan (D-SNP) in South Carolina for members who are eligible for both Medicare and Medicaid. As a provider, understanding how to read member ID cards is essential for accurate identification and service delivery.



What to Look for on the ID Card

All members enrolled in an integrated Dual Special Needs Plan (D-SNP) will receive a specific Wellcare By Absolute Total Care member ID card. This card contains essential details to help you confirm their enrollment in the plan. When reviewing a member's ID card(s), note the following:
